

Autumn Jubilee Wool Stitch Along Needle Keeper From My Carolina Home

For the base, cut two pieces 8 inches x 5 inches, and round the corners. Mark one of the bases with a chalk liner or other marking tool with these intervals. Begin with a one inch line from the left edge, then measure 3-1/2-inches from that line. Next measure over 2-1/2-inches, then a final line which should leave one inch to the right edge

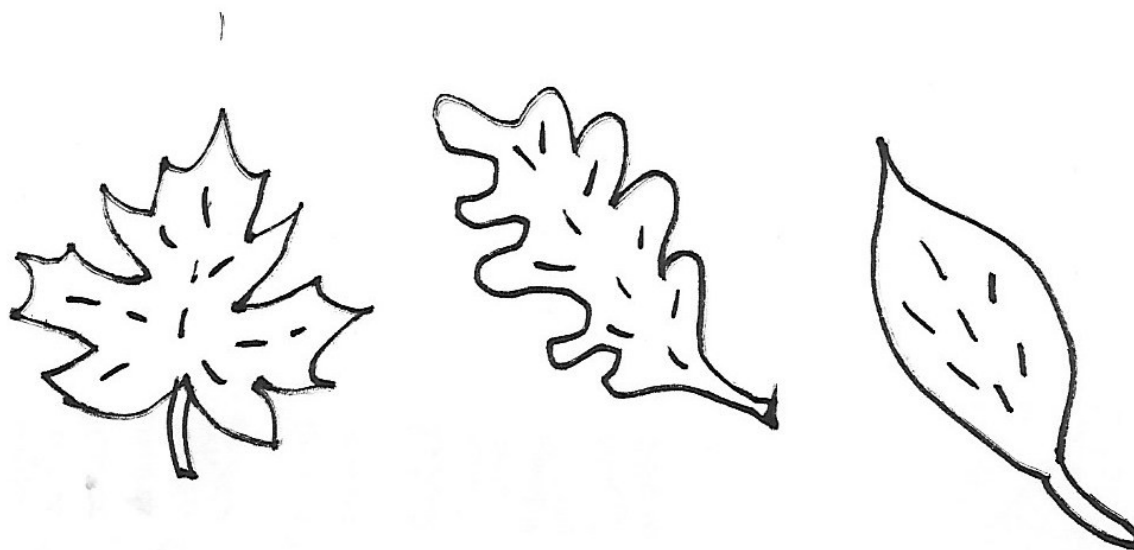
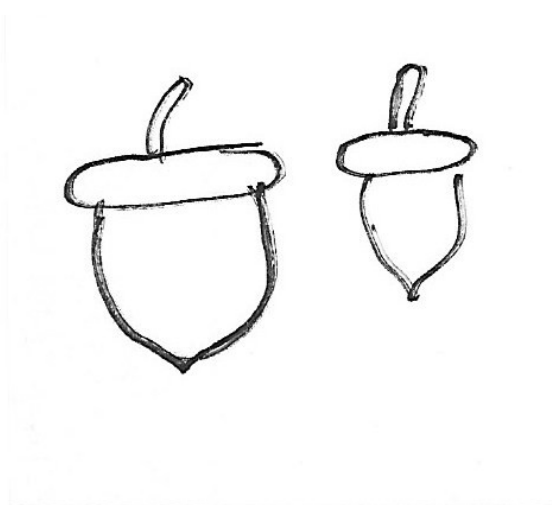


Use the patterns on page 2 to cut out motifs. Arrange motifs in the 2-1/2 inch section, with one on the left side 1-inch section.



Pin and stitch as desired. I use a whip stitch for this part.

You may need to adjust your printer size to get these to print the right size. The large acorn on the left should be 1-1/2 inches from top of stem to acorn point. The maple leaf on the left is roughly 1-1/2 inches square. The long leaf on the right is 2-1/4 inches long.



Don't worry if they are not exact, just get them close. Overlap the motifs a bit more if needed to stay within the stitching area.
