

Autumn Jubilee Quilt Along Week 4 – Borders and Backing

This week we continue with assembly of the quilt.

Autumn Theme Scraps

6-1/2-inch squares – 8

3-1/2-inch squares – 44

3-1/2-inch WOF strips - 4

Using the scrappy 3-1/2 inch squares, make four borders. Two of the borders will have 10 squares each, and the other two will have 12 squares each.

Arrange leaves and 6-1/2-inch fall color squares around center nine patch unit as shown. Sew two color 1 6-1/2 inch units on either side of one leaf unit together for two sides, then attach to center section. Sew remaining units in rows, making sure there are leaves on the corners. Sew rows together and press.

Add scrappy borders to two sides using the 10 square strips. Sew remaining 12-square units to remaining two sides.

Finally, add outer borders with 3-1/2-inch strips. Cut two 3-12 x 36-1/2 and attach to opposite sides. Cut two 3-1/2 x 42-1/2 inches for remaining two sides. Sew final borders on. Press neatly and square.



Audition backing fabrics in the size needed for your project and the manner in which you intend to quilt. If longarming, you'll need 8 inches more length and width for the backing and batting. Next week we quilt and finish.
