Cutting and sewing -

Center square - 6-1/2-inches square - make this an embroidery or a fussy cut

First border - two 1-1/2-inch wide x 6-1/2-inches long strips, and two 1-1/2-inch wide x 8-1/2-inches long strips. Apply shorter strips first to opposite sides, then add longer strips, then add longer strips to the remaining sides.

Second border of Squares - Twenty 2-1/2-inch squares. Sew two sets of four squares in a strip, and two sets of six squares in a strip. Apply shorter strips first to opposite sides, then add longer strips, then add longer strips to the remaining sides.

Third border - two 3-1/2-inch wide x 12-1/2-inches long strips, and two 3-1/2-inch wide x 18-1/2-inches long strips. Apply shorter strips first to opposite sides, then add longer strips to the remaining sides.

Quilt as desired, bind as usual.



Make it in Christmas prints as I've done here, or use your own combination of prints and themes. Use the colors of your kitchen and display on a counter. Use other seasonal prints for spring or fall. Embroider a Thanksgiving sentiment for your holiday table. Your creativity is your guide. Have fun!
