The Fall Fortnight Quilt Along has lots of opportunities for embroidery or applique. You can also change the design to suit any holiday, occasion or holiday theme. Enjoy this free pattern!



**Fabric Requirements**

Scraps for Flying Geese - Four 5-3/4-inch scrappy squares

Background - 1/4 yard

Borders - 1/4 yard needed

Cornerstones - Four 4-1/2-inch squares for cornerstones (add extra if embroidering) of background,

fussy cut image, or prints.

Backing and binding - 1/2 yard

Optional - Pumpkin applique scrap fabrics or wool scraps.

**Cutting**

Scraps - Four 5-3/4-inch scrappy squares (no further cutting needed)

Background -

Sixteen 3-3/8-inch squares

One 6-1/2-inch center square (add extra if embroidering)

Cornerstones - Four 4-1/2-inch squares for cornerstones

(add extra if embroidering) of background, fussy cut image, or prints.

Borders -

Two strips 1-1/2-inch x 6-1/2-inch

Two strips 1-1/2-inch x 8-1/2-inch

Two strips 2-1/2-inch x 16-1/2-inch

Two strips 2-1/2-inch x 20-1/2-inch

## Pumpkin Applique




Smaller pumpkin will fit the  
cornerstones.

Larger pumpkin below is sized for  
the center.

Add extra around the edges of  
each piece for needle-turn.

Cut on the edges for wool  
applique.



## **Instructions**

Complete appliques, embroidery or fussy cutting of center square and cornerstones.

Construct Flying Geese in sets of four using No Waste Method.  
Arrange flying geese in sets of four with four different prints.

Apply 1-1/2 inch borders to center square.

Sew one set of four flying geese to two opposite sides of center square, orienting them as shown in the photo.

Arrange cornerstones on the ends of the remaining two flying geese units.

Sew to opposite ends of the center square-geese sub unit.

Apply final 2-1/2-inch borders to outer edge of top.

Quilt as desired, bind as usual.

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
