

The Most Wonderful Time of Year Table Runner

Fabric Requirements

Sufficient background to embroider 2 sentiments or fall inspired motifs and trim to 6-1/2-inches square,
OR fussy cut motifs 6-1/2-inches square.

Churn Dash center block -

- 2 squares 3-inch scraps
- 2 squares 3-inch background
- 1 square 2-1/2-inch scrap
- 4 strips 1-1/2 x 2-1/2-inches scraps
- 4 strips 1-1/2 x 2-1/2-inches background

Sashing -

- 4 strips 6-1/2-inches x 1-1/2-inches
- 2 strips 22-1/2-inches x 1-1/2-inches

Border -

- 2 strips 22-1/2-inches x 3-1/2-inches
- 2 strips 14-1/2-inches x 3-1/2-inches

Instructions

Begin with embroidering a sentiment or motif, and then embroider a second one. Trim to 6-1/2-inches square. Alternately, fussy cut two motifs 6-1/2-inches square.

While the embroidery machine is working, construct the Churn Dash Center.

Make Churn Dash Center -

Mark the backside of the 3-inch background squares with two diagonal lines corner to corner 1/4-inch away from the center.

Pair the 3-inch scraps with 3-inch backgrounds right sides together and sew on the lines.

Cut apart down the center of the two lines, and press to the dark side.

Pair the scrap strips right sides together with background strips and sew on the long side, press to the darker side.

Arrange center square, half square triangles, and strip sets in a churn dash configuration. Sew in rows.



Arrange the Churn Dash square and the embroidered squares in a row. If using sentiments, place so they are right side up from each end. Add sashing between the blocks. Then add sashing to the edges.



Add final border. Quilt and bind.
