This table cutting will make 4 Bell Blocks

Fabric	Unit size in inches	cut
Gold Texture Print	3 x 3	8
	3-1/2 x 6-1/2	4
	2-1/2 x 6-1/2	4

Background White	8-1/2 x 2-1/2	8

Pull the gold 3-1/2-inch square and one of the BG 3-1/2-inch squares. Cut in half diagonally, then half again to make 4 triangles of each color. We have to do this in this manner to get all the gold on the same side of the white. Arrange the HSTs with the gold on the left and the white to the right along the short edges. Sew together. Cut the remaining two 3-1/2-inch BG triangles in half, and lay out with the HSTs to form Quarter Square Triangles, all the same. Square to 2-1/2-inches. See the blog for tutorial details.

Pull the eight 3-inch squares in both gold and BG, and make HSTs using the Chain Piecing Method. Square to 2-1/2 inches.

Lay out block. Watch the placement of the HSTs. Sew the two rows of three squares at the top together. Then sew that unit to the larger gold piece. Add the accent strip to the bottom and then the final gold strip. Sew HSTs to the long BG strips. Sew block units together.
